Directions to GanderBrook:

Take Exit 63 off I-95 (the Maine turnpike)
Turn LEFT after the toll plaza 'away' from the center of Gray, ME
Turn RIGHT at the first traffic light onto Route 26A (about 3 miles to Dry Mills)
Turn LEFT at Route 26
Turn LEFT at Dry Mills (before the General Mills Store at the flashing light)
Go 5 miles (watch for cemetery on right just before intersection)
You will see a GanderBrook Christian Camp sign on the left at the intersection.
Follow the driveway about 100 yards to the main lodge to register.
